29. Leichter bedeckt.

Eine gute Nacht.

An Floriz [Moriz Violin] (Br. u. ein Brief an v. Cube [Felix-Eberhard von Cube] als Beilage): sende Weisse [Hans Weisse]'s Brief; für Cube eine Korrektur [sic] u. Elias [Angi Elias]-Vorlage: ¹ das Ganze noch zurückgehalten.

Medek wegen einer Beheizung des Vorzimmers – vorläufig zurückgestellt.

Rf.: Fuchs [Robert Fuchs] Serenade Ddur [Serenade No. 1 in D major, Op. 9] (Nilius [Rudolf Nilius]).

29, not as cloudy.

A good night.

To Floriz [Moriz Violin] (letter, and a letter to Cube [Felix-Eberhard von Cube] enclosed): I send Weisse [Hans Weisse]'s letter; for Cube, a set of corrections and Elias [Angi Elias]'s copy.¹

The whole thing is still being held back.
